2017 Pittwater to Coffs Coast Race – starts 27th December Plus Solitary Island Race and return cruise to Pittwater

The iconic Pittwater to Coffs race is back after a year off – now in the hands of the forward thinking Royal Motor Yacht Club. This year the race starts on Pittwater opposite the club – what a spectacle that will be.

Allsail is competing in its exciting Sydney 38 racer - Another Challenge. AC is fresh from a second place in Division 1 of the RMYC Monday Twilight series 2016/17 and 1st place in the RPAYC Lion Island spinnaker series for 2017.

Another Challenge is no stranger to offshore racing having competed in nine Sydney to Hobart races. She will be competing in the Coffs race with a crew of 10 and a full suite of offshore regatta sails.

Coffs race participants are also invited to join the Another Challenge crew in December twilight and weekend races

Newport to Coffs Coast race 27th to 29th December**

The warm water/ shorter alternative to Hobart - 230nm heading north along the beautiful NSW coast. Start time is 1pm on Wednesday– race duration on the Sydney 38 is normally 30 to 48 hours - so at least one night at sea. Race presentation function is on Saturday 30th December

Solitary Island passage race 1pm Sunday 31st December – then party for New Years Eve in Coffs.

Return cruise to Pittwater 1 to 3 January**– subject to weather we leave Coffs on the afternoon of New Years Day and sail overnight to Port Stephens – arriving late afternoon or evening on Tuesday 2nd January (160nm). We overnight in Port Stephens and depart early morning on Tuesday for Pittwater for an evening arrival same day.

Club member/ repeat rate is available to members of Allsail Sailing Club and those who have done past major regattas with Allsail. Note that Allsail Sailing Club Silver PLUS members who regularly crew on Another Challenge get a further 10% discount on the Club member/ repeat rate.

Includes: Crew spot *plus* crew regatta polo shirt for Coffs race crew – pre regatta training day in December - skippers/ instructor, yacht safety gear, race entry fee, insurance, fuel, berthing fees.

Excludes: Accommodation, any food, drink, personal expenses, etc, personal PLB (EPIRB) hire.

Note: PLB EPIRBs are compulsory for the main race and for offshore legs as they include night hours – cost can be shared on each leg - ask us for details.

Allsail is arranging shared (3 bedroom) apartment accommodation near the marina for those doing the whole regatta.
