After 3 days in our traditional hotel/resort we board the gulet in Bodrum and cruise along the renowned turquoise coast of Turkey one way to Gocek. You'll visit must see ancient Knidos, Datca, Bosburun and many more villages and classic bays - with plenty of swim stops along the way.

Our gulet (pronounced goo-let) was built to the design of a traditional Bodrum sailing schooner - then fully re-commissioned with a focus on guest comfort, space, stability and furnished excellence. She boasts two staterooms, and four large double or triple cabins - all air conditioned with their own ensuites.

Her crew of 4 are highly experienced and there to provide the ultimate in service to the 12 passengers*

How it all works and terms and conditions of Allsail's Overseas Sailing Adventures

Allsail has been conducting these hosted overseas sailing adventures since 1996. Each trip is thoroughly researched and pre-planned to ensure excellence of facilities and to maximise customer satisfaction.

Included in the base cost*

- 3 days at a classic Turkey hotel/resort in Bodrum on a twin share basis – including breakfast
- 7 days/ 7 nights aboard a luxury fully equipped and crewed gulet – also twin share
- Five days full board (all meals) and 2 days half board (breakfast/lunch or breakfast/ dinner) on board with meals from our top Turkish chef
- Free commemorative polo shirt and cap
- Welcoming dinner at a top local restaurant
- Diesel for up to 4 hours motoring per day, transit log, yacht repositioning fees

Not Included

- Air travel and taxes, visas, etc
- Port or Marina fees (if applicable), any park fees, extra yacht fuel etc
- Drinks on board from the bar
- Transfers/ taxis/ excursions and any other accommodation required
- Personal travel insurance, personal expenses, other meals and drinks

Our air conditioned gulet has 6 cabins - all with ensuite bathrooms. There are two king master staterooms (\$6,480 per person) and four huge double cabins – some as triple cabins to accommodate singles sharing. (from \$5,980 per person). The resort accommodation is included in the prices – gulet and land accommodation is on a twin share basis.

Arrival airport is Bodrum International.

We spend 3 days at a Bodrum hotel/resort. You can relax by the pool, explore Bodrum and the classic castle at the port or even go on an excursion inland. Our welcoming dinner will be in Bodrum at a top local venue.

On Saturday afternoon we board our gulet at Bodrum. We then spend 7 fabulous days motoring and sailing the Turkish coast.

The gulet is crewed by a skipper, 2 crew and a chef - and comes with a large tender and many water toys. Most nights we dine on board - but have reserved two meals where we all eat onshore in rustic local restaurants. Our private yacht has full steward bar service all day and into the night – the crew are there to look after our every need. As most items are covered there is only a need for a minimal kitty of around 200AUD per person which should be adequate to cover the extras. You pay for your alcoholic drinks – and there is also an obligatory crew tip – around AUD200 per person.

Most nights we will be berthed at harbours but some nights are planned at anchor when you will feast on our chef's excellent multi-course Turkish meals. We plan onshore time for sightseeing, dining, shopping etc.

We disembark at Gocek around 10am on the Saturday. Departure airport is nearby Dalaman International.

How to pay:

You pay a deposit of \$1,500 per person to reserve your berth or cabin. This is non-refundable if you later pull out. Deposits are payable on completion of booking form. Payments are then made in two further instalments with the last payment due two months before cruise departure date. Specific details are on the booking form.

We ask you to get your deposit in promptly. Allsail has to pay the charterers significant deposits to secure the best appropriate yacht. We don't like to travel second class when cruising in the Mediterranean.

We can advise re pre and post cruising options – there are some great deals on the internet - or our travel agent can arrange to book for you. We require that you take out travel insurance to protect yourself against unforeseen issues or if you cannot travel.

We want you to have a memorable trip like all – and I mean all – of the previous Allsail cruising adventures. That's why we have so many repeat cruisers. Talk to Russell or Cherie at any time for some hints. With most meals included in the package you should be able to budget for around AUD150 per day whilst on the gulet for the kitty, other food, drinks, crew tip, extras etc – but it's still easy to spend more or less depending on your style.
