Allsail's Entry

Allsail is returning for the seventeenth year – again with Leeward it's Beneteau First 40 racer – competing in the 5 passage races of the Commodore's Cup in PHS Performance Division Non Spinnaker.

Leeward came equal first in 2023, – alas 2nd on a countback - and will be keen to go one better in 2026. Over the years we have had success with Dancing Star and Another Challenge with 2nd in the Commodore's Cup in 2013 and many individual race wins and podiums. Another Challenge took line honours in Race 1 in 2021.

But we're still looking for that elusive series win. So for 2026 we are again taking Leeward – a proven racer at the CYCA and Hamilton Island – Winner of the RMYC island series and 1st in the Red racer division of the Monday Twilights – plus second in the Pittwater regatta. She has a full suite of racing sails and a powerful Hood mainsail. We'll be working hard for that elusive series win – or podium.

- ♣ Sunday 12th April: Newcastle to Pt Stephens race (35nm) – to our regatta berth at the marina in Nelson Bay
- Monday 13th to Saturday 18th April: Commodore's Cup series of 5 passage races on Port Stephens and around surrounding islands. Presentation dinner on Saturday night (at attendees' cost)
- **↓ Thursday is a lay day –** great day for our traditional lunch at the Fisherman's Wharf restaurant (attendees' cost)
- Sunday 19th April:
